What's in a name?

It is created by muting the bell of a trumpet or other brass wind instrument with a device known as a 'wah-wah'. Despite the playful origin of Wind Band's white blend name, you can be sure that a glass of it is always a winning choice.

Winemaking

Handpicked grapes were gently pressed in an inert press to preserve freshness and purity. The juice was settled and racked before undergoing natural fermentation without the addition of cultured yeast. Following fermentation, the wine was matured on its fine lees for six months, developing greater texture and complexity before being racked and bottled.
